**EXPLANATION:** The Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools request initial funding of \$1,600,000 for the Safety and Camera Updates Project from the 2016 Schools Capital Projects Ordinance from the General Fund. The Schools also request to transfer \$44,695.50 from the Meadowlark Middle Traffic Project to the Safety and Camera Updates Project.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT THE 2016 SCHOOLS CAPITAL PROJECTS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

WSFCS requests funds adjustment from the 2017 Local Bonds for the projects as indicated below.

We request that this additional funding plus \$44,695.50 of the initial funding balance be allocated to the Safety and Camera Updates project. On March 13, 2018, our Board of Education voted to delay the Traffic Improvement work at Meadowlark Elementary and Middle Schools. It is not anticipated that this work will be done prior to the second issuance of bond funds.
