SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2020-2021 BUDGET ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$15,500 OF RESERVED FUND BALANCE FROM A GRANT RECEIVED FROM THE WINSTON-SALEM FOUNDATION FOR THE STEPPING UP PROGRAM

COUNTY MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION OR COMMENTS: Recommend Approval

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

The Forsyth County Department of Public Health's Stepping Up Program is an effort to reduce the number of adults with mental and co-occurring substance used disorders in jails and reduce recidivism that provides screening, transition planning, support, and case management.

In August 2019, the Stepping Up Program received a grant of \$17,500 from the Winston-Salem Foundation to assist participants with housing/rental assistance. At the close of Fiscal Year 2020, \$15,500 of funding remains due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Winston-Salem Foundation has agreed to extend the grant until January 31, 2021, so this agenda item is necessary to appropriate \$15,500 of restricted fund balance.
