### SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

The Forsyth County Department of Public Health has received \$2,941.00 in additional funding from the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, Environmental Health Section for Zika Preparedness Activities to determine the potential local risk of transmission of the Zika Virus by evaluating the presence of container-inhabiting mosquitoes in North Carolina. The funding period for these funds is May 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016.

Funds will be used to purchase equipment and supplies needed to conduct surveys.

The additional \$2,941.00 in non-recurring grant funds will support the Health Department's Zika Preparedness initiatives.
