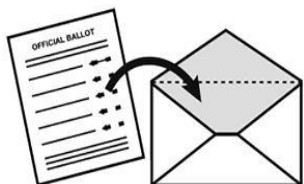

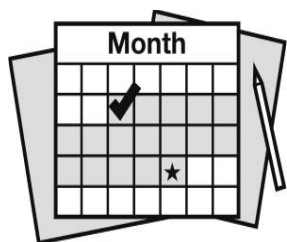
# Ways to vote

## Absentee By-Mail



Request an absentee ballot **by 5:00 p.m. on October 29th**. Absentee ballots must be returned to the Board of Elections office by **November 5<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m.** Download the form at [www.fcvotes.com](http://www.fcvotes.com).

## Early Voting



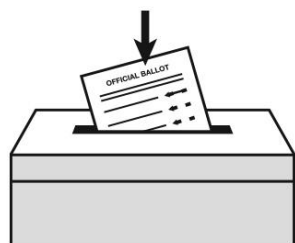
Early Voting will be held from **October 17<sup>th</sup> to November 2nd**. Check online at [www.fcvotes.com](http://www.fcvotes.com) for time and sites.

You can also register to vote or update your voter information (except party affiliation) during Early Voting.

# Deadlines



## **October 11<sup>th</sup> by 5:00 p.m.**

Last day to register to vote, or update your address, name, or party.

*If you move, your polling place may change.  
Be sure to update your voter registration address every time you move.*

## **October 29<sup>th</sup> by 5:00 p.m**

Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail.

## **November 2<sup>nd</sup> by 3:00 p.m.**

Last day to vote Early Voting. Check online at [www.fcvotes.com](http://www.fcvotes.com) for the list of sites.

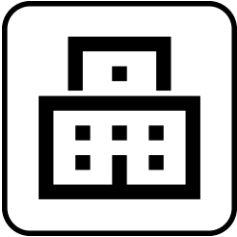
## **November 5<sup>th</sup> -Election Day**

Polls are open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.



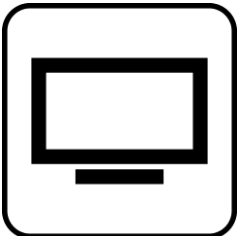

# Voter Assistance

## All Voting Sites are Handicap Accessible

### Who May Assist a Voter?

- Near relatives, including, spouse, parent, child, sibling, grandparent, grandchild, in-law, stepparent and stepchild
- Others, except for those listed below, may assist the voter **ONLY IF** the voter is blind, disabled, or illiterate
- Poll workers may assist any voter



### Who May NOT Assist a Voter?

- Voter's employer
- Agent of the voter's employer
- Officer or agent of the voter's union
- Anyone by telephone

### Curbside Voting

If you are unable to enter the voting place because of age or physical disability, you may vote from your vehicle. Alert a precinct official of your desire to vote in this manner.



# What to expect at the polls

When you arrive, precinct officials will be there to help you.

## Check in

State your name, present an acceptable form of Photo I.D and state your residential address.

Does it include all contests for your district?



## Go to the voting booth and mark your ballot



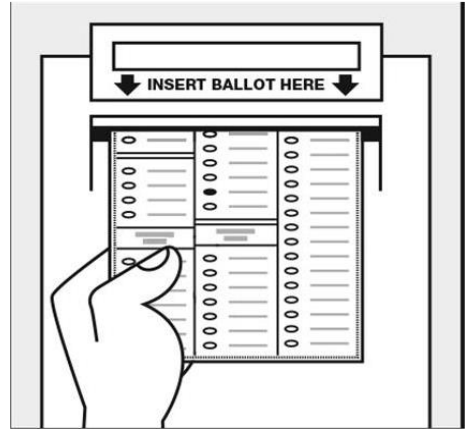
## Place ballot in the tabulator

## To vote on a paper ballot

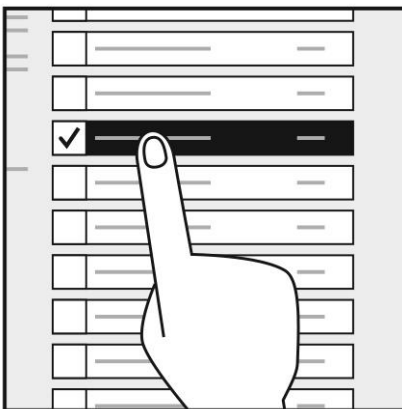


Make your selection by filling in the oval next to your choice(s).

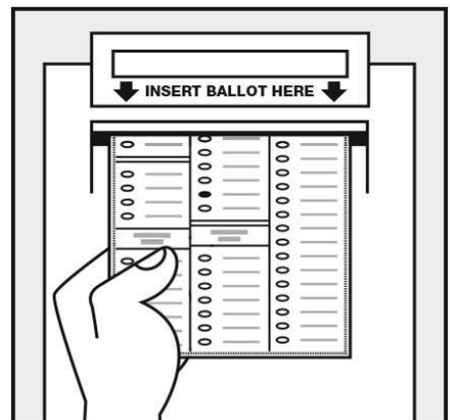


Review and insert your ballot into the tabulator
